**INFORMATION CLAUSE ON THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA FOR PARTICIPANTS OF  
EVENTS ORGANIZED BY THE INSTITUTE  
ŁUKASIEWICZ Research Network - PORT Polish Center for Technology Development**

**1. Data Controller**

The Controller of personal data is the ŁUKASIEWICZ Research Network Institute - PORT Polish Center for Technology Development (hereinafter: the "Institute" and/or "Controller") located in Wrocław, operating in the form of an institute included in the ŁUKASIEWICZ Research Network, being a state legal person, having legal personality, operating based on an entry in the National Court Register with the number 0000850580; NIP (Tax Identification Number): 8943140523.

**2. Data Protection Officer**

The Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer - a person who is responsible for contact in all matters regarding the processing of personal data and the exercise of rights related to data processing. The Inspector should be contacted by e-mail: [iod@port.lukasiewicz.gov.pl](mailto:iod@port.lukasiewicz.gov.pl) or in writing at the address of the Administrator's seat (ul. Stabłowicka 147 str., 54-066 Wrocław).

**3. Data range**

The administrator processes your personal data in the following areas:

- a) names and surname,
- b) email address,
- c) phone number.

**4. The basis for data processing**

Your personal data, in the scope of names and surnames and e-mail addresses, are processed on a basis of Article 6 paragraph 1 letter b of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons about the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter "GDPR") – processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or to take steps at the request of the data subject before entering into a contract.

Your personal data, in the scope of names and surnames and phone numbers, are processed on a basis of Article 6 paragraph 1 letter d of GDPR – processing is necessary to protect the vital interests of the data subject or another natural person – personal data are necessary to ensure epidemiological and sanitary safety (prevent human infections), inform participants of the event in case of SARS-CoV-2 infection of an event participant.



## **5. Purpose of data processing**

The purpose of processing your personal data is the exercise of the rights and obligations arising from the contract and the implementation of organizational and administrative activities related to the above.

## **6. Period time of data processing**

Your personal data is processed for the duration and performance of the contract and after the end of this period, for the time necessary to secure the Administrator's claims, i.e. for the period set for the limitation of claims and criminal acts.

## **7. Data sharing and recipients**

Personal data may be shared with the following recipients:

- a) entities authorized to receive it based on applicable law,
- b) other entities, based on concluded contracts, process personal data on behalf of the Controller (e.g. entities providing IT services, legal services, etc.).

Your personal data is not transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area (third country) and international organizations.

## **8. Profiling**

Processed personal data are not subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.

## **9. Rights of the data subject**

The data subject has the right to:

- a) access to your data and receive a copy thereof;
- b) rectify (correct) your data;
- c) request removal of personal data,
- d) requests to limit data processing;
- e) object to data processing;
- f) lodging a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (to the address of the Office for Personal Data Protection, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw).

To exercise the above rights, please contact the Data Administrator with the Personal Data Protection Inspector, in the manner indicated in point 2 of this clause.
